YOUTH APPLICATION PROCESS FOR THE HIGH SCHOOL MISSION TRIP:

1. Eligibility for the High School Mission Trip:
The current 8TH-12TH graders in the school year of 2016-17 are eligible to go to the high school Nashville trip
2. All youth application forms must be submitted by **Dec. 18, 2016, with a deposit of \$50**. An individual fee is \$250 per person, and the remaining balance of \$200 is due on June 30.
3. The Youth Advisory Advocacy Council (YAAC) members will review all youth applications, and late applications will be accepted only at the discretion of the council.
4. YAAC will also grant a need-based scholarship upon an applicant's request, and the scholarship application form must be submitted no later than Dec. 18, 2016.
5. A youth applicant MUST attend all the required training & workday meetings, or meet with appropriate staff person for a different make-up session scheduled both by the staff and the applicant.
 - Training Session 1: **Feb. 12, 2017, 5-6:30 pm** (a lunch snack is provided)
 - Training Session 2: **Apr. 2, 2017, 5-6:30 pm** (a dinner snack is provided)
 - Final Training: **June. 25, 2017, 5-6 pm**
6. An adult applicant MUST participate in the following mission trip fundraisers—
 - “Youth **“Bake/Cake-in-a-Jar Sale”** on Dec. 17-18, 2016: Saturday shifts for baking and setting up (9-10:30am & 10:30-12pm), and Sunday sale (9am-12:30pm) in Fellowship Hall and Hallway (each family is expected to bring (homemade baked) cookies and cakes on Sunday by 8:30am.
 - **“Car Wash”**: Apr 22, 2017 (from 9am to 3pm)
 - **“Take-Stock-In-Mission”**: January through August, 2017
